

Capitol Park

- Σ State government complex
- Σ Consistent architectural style
- Σ Includes: State Capitol building, Capitol Annex, State Library, Arsenal Museum, Pentagon Barracks, the Claiborne, Poydras, Galvez, Livingston, and LaSalle Buildings. Currently under construction are the Bienville and Iberville Buildings, a Visitor's Center and the State Museum.

Spanish Town

- Σ Single-family and multi-family housing, with a mix of architectural styles and types
- Σ Includes office and commercial uses
- Σ Listed on the National Register of Historic Places
- Σ Close Proximity to the Capitol Park

Central Business District

- Σ The metropolitan region's commercial core
- Σ Third Street is eligible for designation on the National Register of Historic Places, currently has individual structures designated
- Σ Includes: Post Office, Federal Courthouse

Beauregard Town

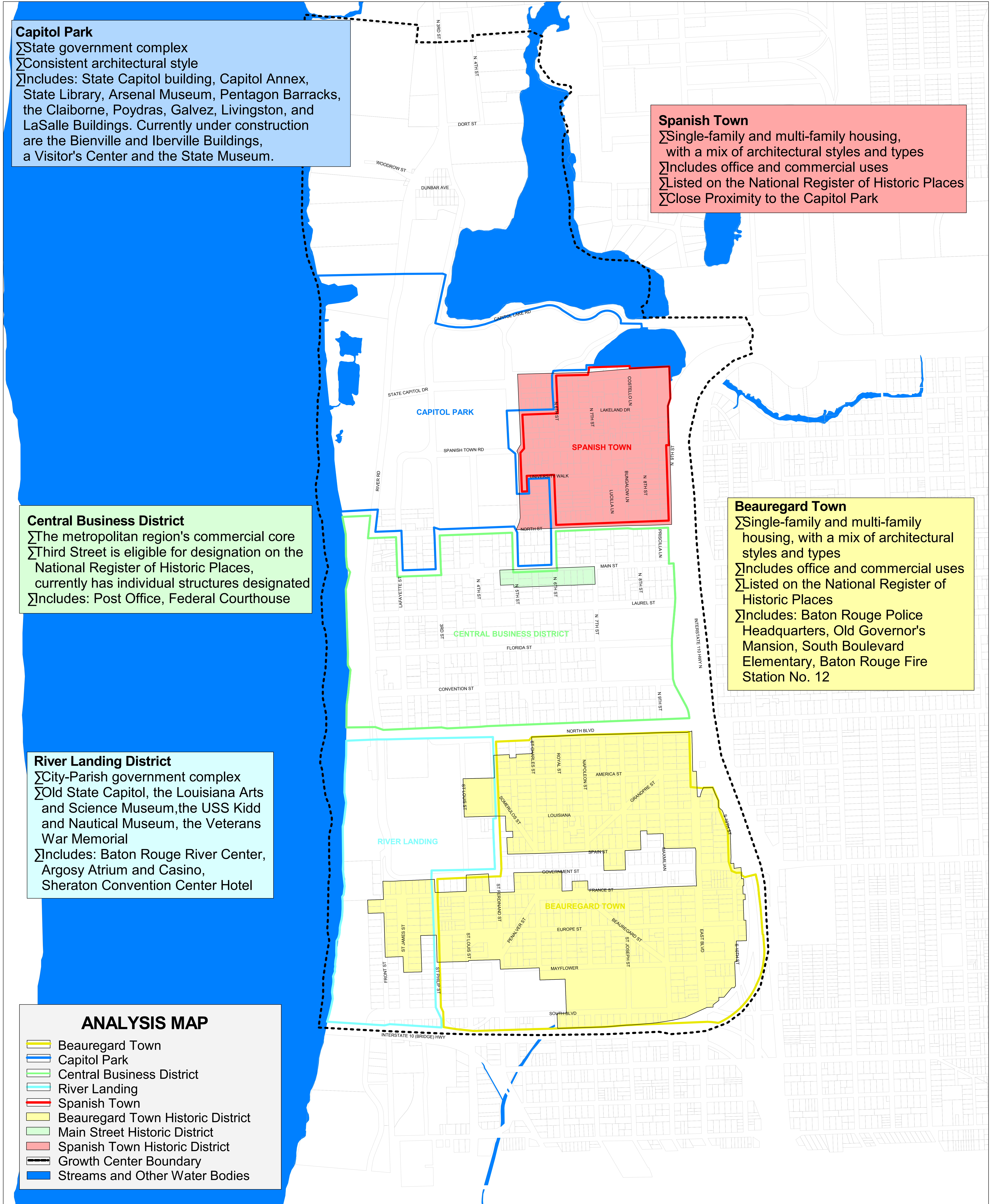
- Σ Single-family and multi-family housing, with a mix of architectural styles and types

- Σ City-Parish government complex
- Σ Old State Capitol, the Louisiana Arts and Science Museum, the USS Kidd and Nautical Museum, the Veterans War Memorial
- Σ Includes: Baton Rouge River Center, Argosy Atrium and Casino, Sheraton Convention Center Hotel
