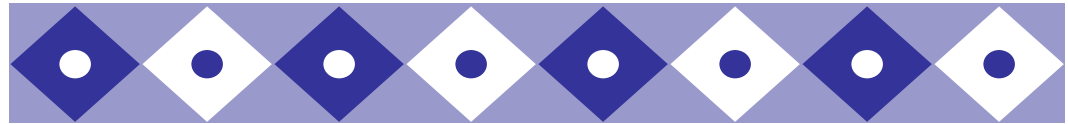

At the Commission on Accreditation for Law Enforcement Agencies (CALEA) summer conference in Montreal, Quebec, the Baton Rouge Police Department was awarded their 3rd re-accreditation award. The department successfully completed an onsite review where they were told that they would be recommended for reaccreditation for the next three years. The accreditation team was in compliance with a total of 446 standards. We had no standards in non-compliance. Our Static Displays, Public Forum, and Public Call-in Sessions received favorable reviews from our assessors. We, the Baton Rouge Police Department would like to thank everyone that took part in this process. Without you it would not have happened. Your calls, presence at the forum, comments, and suggestions were appreciated and did not go unnoticed in this worthwhile process.

- All officers were issued body armor
- Dispatchers consoles were updated with additional safety features
- Portable radios became available for all field officers
- Employees' grievances were analyzed to spot trends and improve morale
- The department conducted workload assessments to better allocate manpower

- A plan for continuous in-service training was developed
