

PROMULGATION STATEMENT

The East Baton Rouge Parish Mayor's Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Preparedness (MOHSEP) has the authority and responsibility for direction and control of the resources of East Baton Rouge Parish as set forth in the East Baton Rouge Parish Emergency Operations Plan.

Transmitted herewith is the new All Hazard Emergency Operations Plan for East Baton Rouge Parish. This plan supersedes any previous Emergency Operations Plan promulgated for this purpose. It provides a framework in which the parish and its political subdivisions can plan and perform their respective functions during a disaster or national security threat.

This plan is in accordance with existing federal, state and local statutes and understandings of the various departments involved. It has been concurred in by the East Baton Rouge Parish Administration, the Governor's Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Preparedness (GOHSEP) and the Federal Emergency Management Agency. It will be reviewed and recertified annually by the Director of the East Baton Rouge Parish Mayor's Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Preparedness. All recipients are requested to advise the East Baton Rouge Parish Mayor's Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Preparedness of any changes which might result in its improvement or increase in its usefulness.
